Hancock County Board of Education Meets State Approval

The Hancock County Board of Education is pleased to announce that the SBOE at a hearing in Atlanta Thursday, August 24, 2017, decided to recommend to the Governor that the members of the Board of Education not be removed from office. This decision is based upon the action of AdvancED to move the School District from “accredited under review” to “accredited.”

The Board of Education and leadership of the School District have been working actively with AdvancED to meet the goals set forth in its monitoring review report. As a result of this

work, AdvancED removed any review status effective July 3, 2017. The Board of Education, Superintendent, and leadership of the School District remain committed to providing the best possible education to all of the students of Hancock County.

On June 14, 2017, Superintendent Dr. Charles R. Culver presented the Hancock County School District's accountability report to the State Board of Education, which documented improvement across schools, grades, content areas, and in administration and staff stability. M. E. Lewis Elementary School and Hancock Central Middle School are included among "1,000+ Schools that Beat the Odd in 2016."
